- **SIZE** every image to the following :

 - Height is 1200 pixels maximum
 - File size 2MB maximum

If you are entering creative, it might be a good idea to also note in the image name it is a creative entry.

The **Individual section** is a Set Subject "Patterns" and is for monochrome images.

"Patterns" is defined as an arrangement of subjects, shapes or colour which is interesting or aesthetically pleasing to the eye. These will be uploaded by individual members and the tentative closing date is 28th February. More information to follow on this section.

To clarify: there are NO prints required, this is a digital competition only.
